Team Descriptions and Responsibilities

Events Team: The Events Team will help to plan and execute events for the Youth. Members of the Events Team are expected to do the following: (i) meet quarterly to help plan the events for the following quarter; (ii) arrive early for at least one event each quarter to help prepare for that event (students will work with their team leaders to determine which event works best for them and the team); (iii) participate in the event planning sessions and respond to their leaders' communications regarding ministry events.

Welcome Team: The Welcome Team will help to welcome guest and integrate fellow student into their respective peer groups. Members of the Welcome Team are expected to do the following: (i) attend Sunday morning Youth BFG an average of three out of five Sundays each quarter (absences due to family actives are considered an exception); (ii) arrive at BFG on time in order to help greet and engage fellow students.

Missions Team: The Missions Team will assist the Youth in fostering a missional mindset and in planning missional outreaches/events. Members of the Missions Team must be baptized members of Ninth & O and are expected to participate in the majority of the bi-monthly meetings.
